The Basic Umpiring Course has been designed to include seven 90-minute modules all of which include some theory and some physical activity.

The seven modules included in the Course are:

- Introduction to Umpiring**
 - Positioning**
 - Decision Making**
 - Communication**
- Boundary Umpiring**
 - Goal Umpiring**
- Fitness and Nutrition**

The Course can be adapted to suit individual school's timetable restrictions and is both VET and Australian Curriculum compliant.
